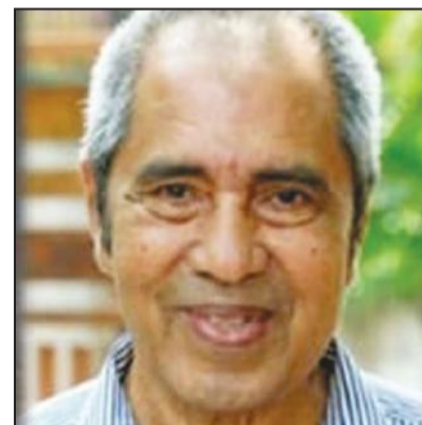

Mr N P George is an industrialist by profession and a philanthropist by soul. The Nambiyattukudy Charitable Memorial Trust which is the charity arm of Pavizham rice is headed by him. The trust provides medical assistance for sick and ailing, home for homeless, marriage help for economical deprived, among the dwellers of Koovappady Panchayat, the annual charity budget of for each year since inception of the trust a decade back is Rs1 Crore/ per year, besides the trust is providing drinking water in an entire nearby hilly area that do not have drinking water facilities so far.
His Pavizham rice is the largest agro food processor in Kerala and provides 1/5th of the rice requirement of the state and their products are exported to U.S, U.K, Middle East and Europe. He and his firms are in receipt of the various central and state agency awards.

Nazarmanu



Nazarmanu is the fifth child of K. Moitheen Haji and Fatima in Pangchendi, Kurua Panchayat, Malappuram district. After learning the greatness of philanthropy from his parents, he became active in the field of social-service since 1995. In his own village, Pangchendi, he took a stand against usurers and started an interest-free loan scheme of Rs 20 lakhs from his own investment and that became very helpful to the common people. The sick, widows, Anganwadis and palliative centers are constantly being helped. More than 400 houses were built for the poor under his leadership. Since 1995, food kits have been provided in the months of Ramzan irrespective of caste and religion. Around 15000 kits are being distributed this year. Free dialysis is being provided to 53 people. He has brought an ambulance and found 15 cents of land for a palliative care center in his own village Pangchendi. Nasser Manu has an illuminating history on the path of philanthropy.

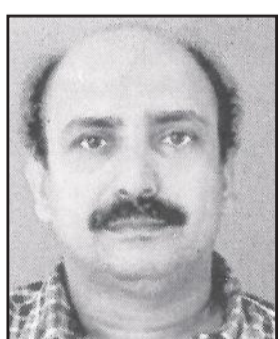

Early Life

Kunhamu was not a person who was born with a silver spoon. Hewas born in 1956 into an ordinary family, as the son of Methal Valappil Parakkot Ahmad and Pathey Hajjamma, at Perumanna in Kozhikode District. Due to the adverse circumstances posed by life, Kunhamu had to discontinue his studies midway, but Kunhamu's grit and determination helped him find his niche later. Like any of his contemporaries, Kunhamu as a young man, dreamed of securing a Government job, which was the normal trend of those times for an ordinary Malayali man in the Malabar region. Kunhamu tried applying to the KSRTC for the post of Garage Mazdur, but as fate would have it, the shortlisting for this vacancy was delayed. Kunhamu knocked several doors, tried to get influential referrals, but it was all in vain. It was around this time that the then Public Works Department Minister Mr.P.M.Aboobacker advised Kunhamu to venture into the construction industry, which later changed his destiny. Though Kunhamu was not a heir to the legacy of business in the construction industry, his father owned a small business. This business later paved the way to Kunhamu's entry into the world of business, and thus "the man named Kunhamu was christened into the construction industry". This was how he started building structures of steel and cement, hallmarked by the symbol of trustworthiness. Had Kunhamu opted for the career of an ordinary man with a mediocre Government job, the construction industry would have missed " M. V. Kunhamu the contractor, the icon of belief and trust of millions" . Indeed, Man desires and God decides.

Initial years in the Construction Industry

Kunhamu, is one of the rare contractors who has built several schools, offices, complexes and mosques in Kerala, which are renowned for their beauty and architectural excellence. Despite being a person who had hardly completed his primary education, Kunhamu used the most novel techniques of construction and launched his large scale construction company . Since 1979, Kunhamu's construction company started pilot projects on a smallscale in and around Kozhikode District. The construction company then secured Class 'C' Licence and later a Class 'A' License from thePublic Works Department. The initial project undertaken by Kunhamu was for the construction of two small houses. In 1979, the C.I.R School at Mathara, was in the process of constructing a school building. Being a person belonging to the same village, M.V.Kunhamu was at an advantage to secure the contract for construction of this school building.

This marked Kunhamu's rise to the peak of success. Presently, Kunhamu is the the Managing Director of M.V.K and Associates, and M.V.K Constructions, the two renown ISO Certified entities in the Construction Industry. There after, Kunhamu never had to retrace his steps from the Construction Industry. When asked about his success in life and business, Kunhamu /humbly mentions "effective leadership" and "proficiency" as the key ingredients to his success. When he looks back, he feels grateful for having been able to learn from his experiences and get better at things each time. His integrity, coordination skills, and timeliness in completing projects, immensely helped him to win the trust of his customers. Moreover, his tireless perseverance and rigorous dedication were the true comrades to his success. Above all, he firmly believes that the Good Grace of God, the Merciful, is the pivot around which his success story oscillates, and this great man offers his humble gratitude to God.

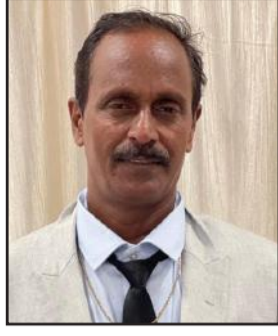

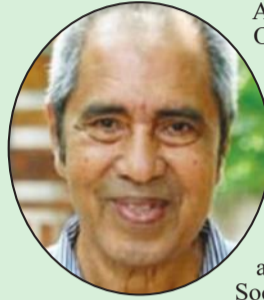
